<b>Bars</b>	Closed	25% capacity or 75 people †
<b>Gyms/Fitness</b>	50% capacity or 50 people †	100% capacity; 6 feet between parties
<b>Group Sports and Camps</b>	25 person capacity per activity	50 person capacity per activity
<b>Retail</b>	50% capacity	75% capacity
<b>Indoor Unseated Events and Entertainment</b>	50%, 50 people no calculator (or up to 150 with calculator) †	50%, 175 people †
<b>Indoor Seated Events and Entertainment</b>	50% capacity or 50 people (or 150 people with 6ft spacing between groups) †	50% capacity or 225 people with 6ft spacing between groups †
<b>Outdoor Unseated Events and Entertainment</b>	50% capacity or 175 people †	No state regulations, but locals may choose local restrictions
<b>Outdoor Seated Events and Entertainment</b>	50% capacity or 175 people †	No state regulations, but locals may choose local restrictions
<b>Outdoor Guided Services</b>	50% capacity or 10 people †	No state regulations, but locals may choose local restrictions.

† When capacity limits are expressed as both a percentage of posted capacity and a total number of people, use whichever number is fewer.
